As you are probably aware, Lebanon has enacted a law that enables its **Lebanese Citizens** (Exclusively for holders of Lebanese citizenship and those who will be 21 years or older by the end of this year) living abroad to exercise in their countries of residency their voting rights in the Lebanese parliamentary elections.

The Lebanese government has been working hard to lay the appropriate and effective foundations for holding this unprecedented immigrant voting in the upcoming legislative election in 2013.

Towards this national objective, I hereby call on you to take part in this democratic process.

In order to become eligible for voting in the United States, you need to initiate the following registration process by filling the [registration form](#) and providing the required documents as mentioned in the registration form.
